MEMBERSHIP DISCLAIMER FORM:

By payment of these membership dues to Wedgwood Circle and my signature below,

I signify my understanding that:

1. Wedgwood Circle is a membership organization seeking the renewal of the culture by facilitating investment in the creation of cultural "artifacts" in the key influential sectors of film, music, television, publishing, theatre, fashion, fine arts, graphic novels, gaming and interactive media.
2. Any and all information distributed by Wedgwood Circle, its officers and directors and other members, shall be for information purposes only and is not intended to be, and is not, nor shall it be deemed to be, an endorsement, approval or other recommendation with respect to securities and/or investments. Additionally, dissemination of information by the Wedgwood Circle does not constitute an endorsement of the accuracy or adequacy of the information therein.
3. Wedgwood Circle is not a venture fund, investment bank, broker/dealer, investment clearinghouse, investment portal, or any other form of investment advisor or otherwise, and because of the venture capital exemption rule, is not registered with the Securities and Exchange Commission or any state securities commission.
4. With respect to securities and/or investments, the member will be responsible for (i) obtaining such additional information as he or she deems necessary (ii) evaluating the relative merits and risks therein and/or (iii) consulting with his or her individual investment advisor. As a result, I recognize and agree that neither Wedgwood Circle nor its representatives or agents are responsible or liable for any investment decision I make as a result of being a member of Wedgwood Circle.
5. I (or the charitable organization that I represent) am an accredited investor, as defined by Regulation D of the SEC. For an individual investor, this means my individual net worth, or joint net worth with my spouse, exceeds \$1,000,000 excluding the value of my primary residence, or that I had an individual income in excess of \$200,000 in each of the two most recent years or joint income with my spouse in excess of \$300,000 in each of those years and has a reasonable expectation of reaching the same income level in the current year. For a charitable organization, this means with assets exceeding \$5 million.
6. \$500 of each contribution to the Wedgwood Circle Institute is the value of the services that will be provided to each donor by the Angel Group to support for-profit deal vetting, and \$500 for the fair market value of services rendered. For a charitable deduction, these amounts must be subtracted from the contribution to determine the amount deductible. The full amount may be deductible as a business expense.
7. Companies circulating their business ideas to Wedgwood members are understandably concerned about privacy protection. As such, I will not share briefings or company information with non-members.
